## TRIBAL CONSULTATIONS

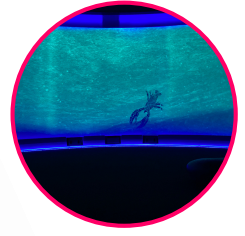

FAM curatorial staff collaborated with Yuchi tribal leaders to select these representative objects and interpretive materials.

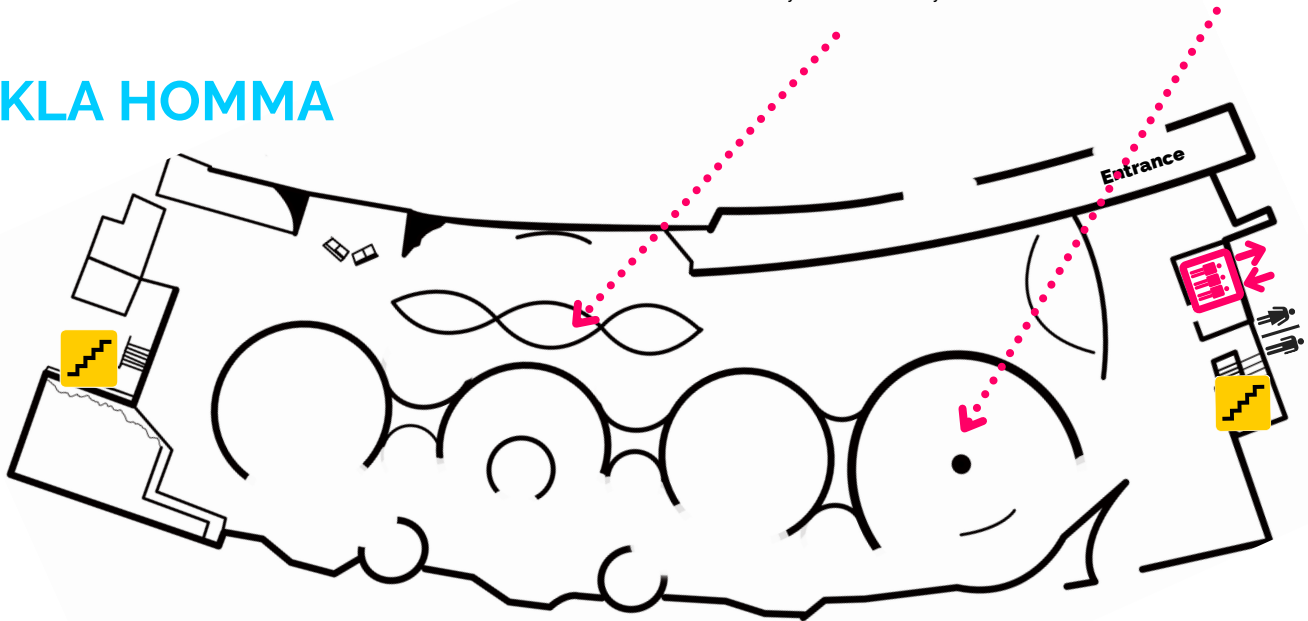


Object: Professional Tennis Player Dawn Kelly Allen

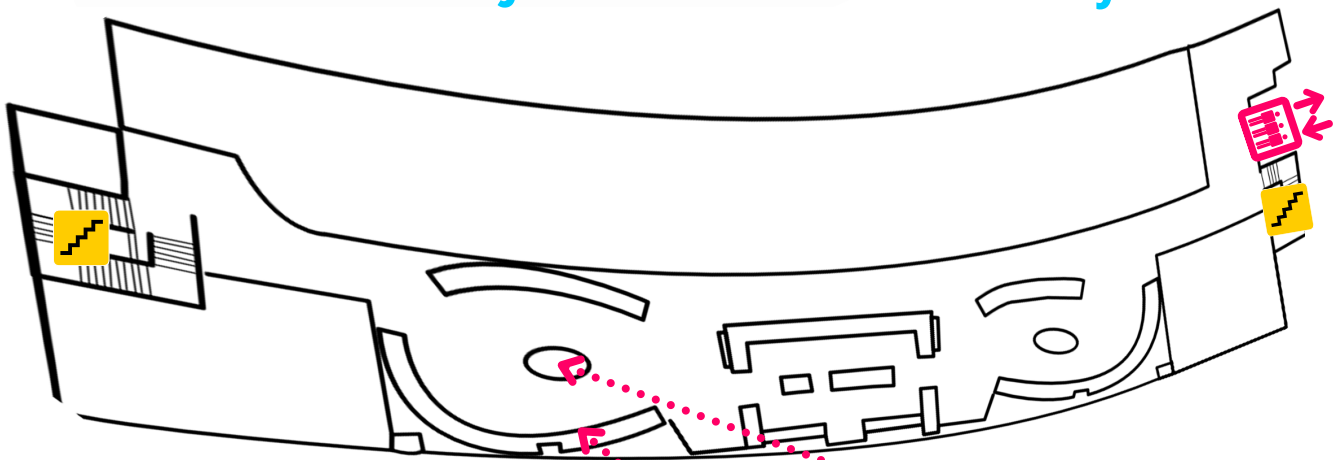

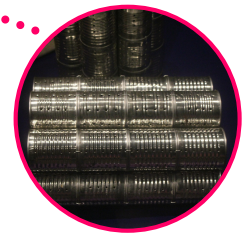
