TRIBAL CONSULTATIONS

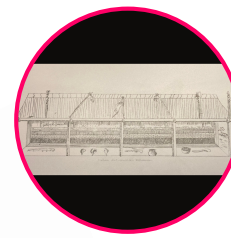

FAM curatorial staff collaborated with Alabama-Quassarte tribal leaders to select these representative objects and interpretive materials.

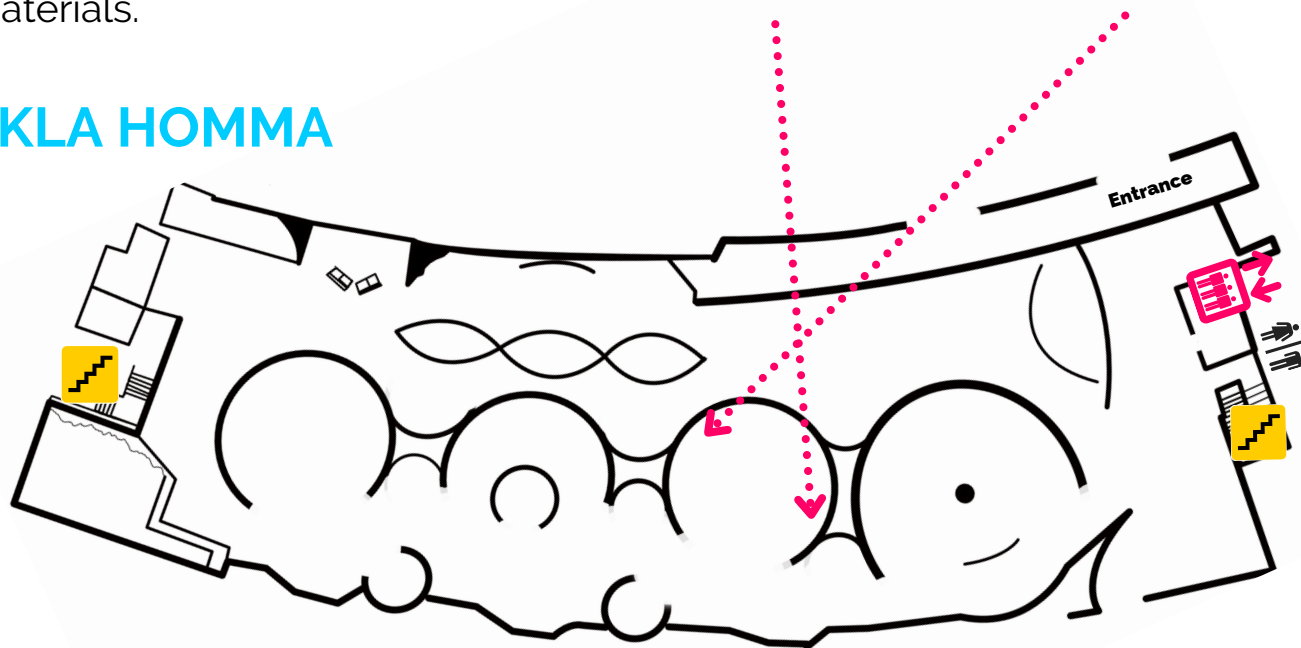


Panel: Moundville

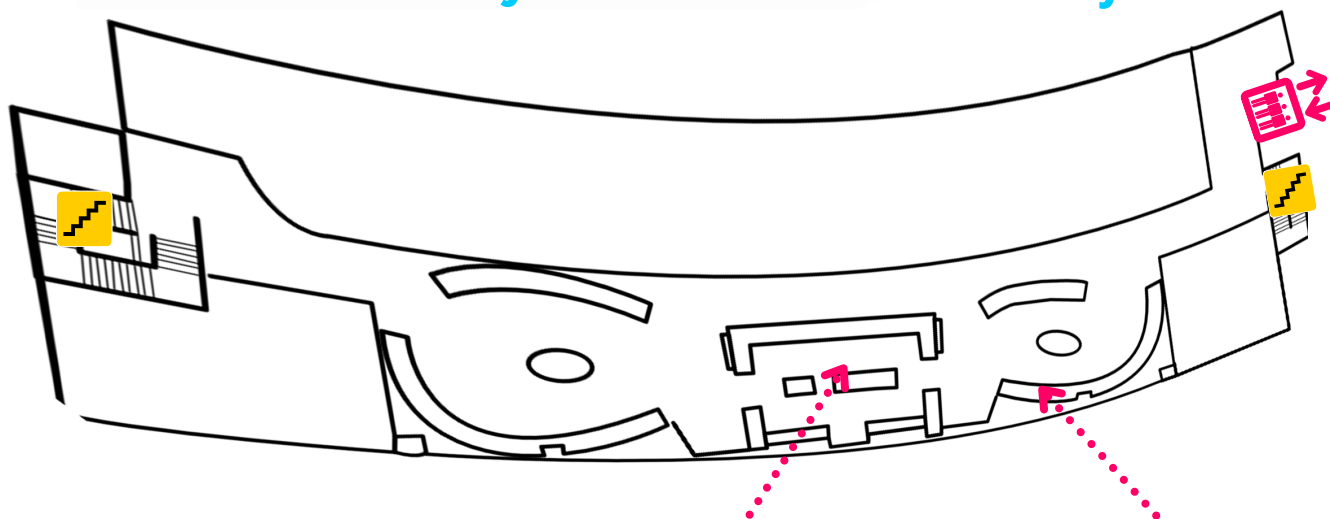


Panel: Alabama Square Ground
