## TRIBAL CONSULTATIONS

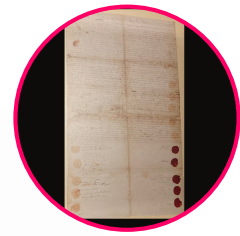

FAM curatorial staff collaborated with Delaware Nation tribal leaders to select these representative objects and interpretive materials.

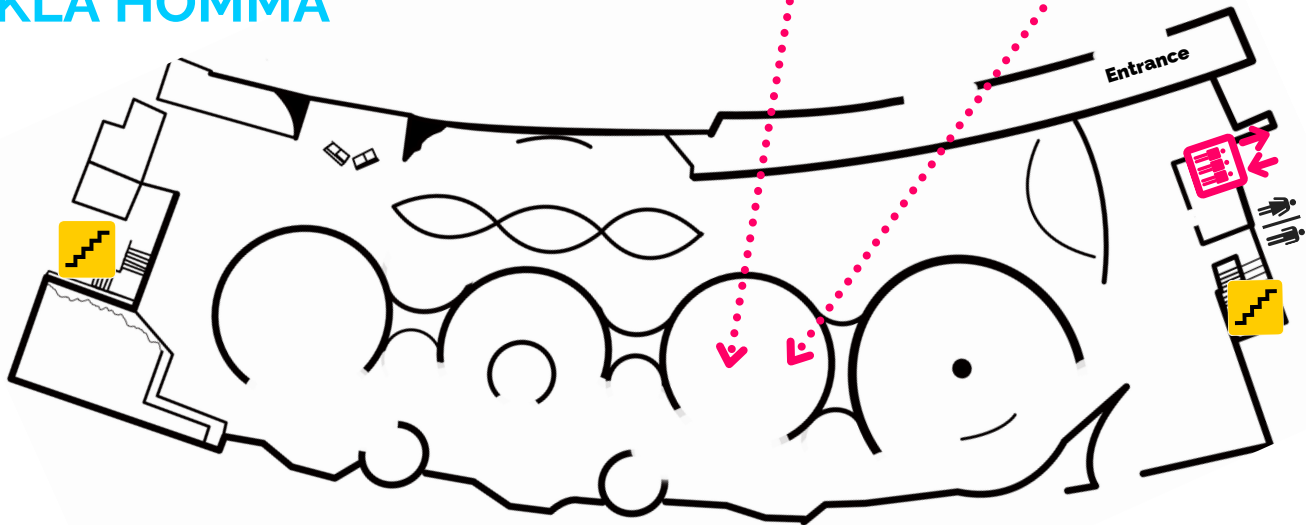


Panel: Ga Nu Ni Dis Se Nu U Ne Go Nus  
(I come from Water)

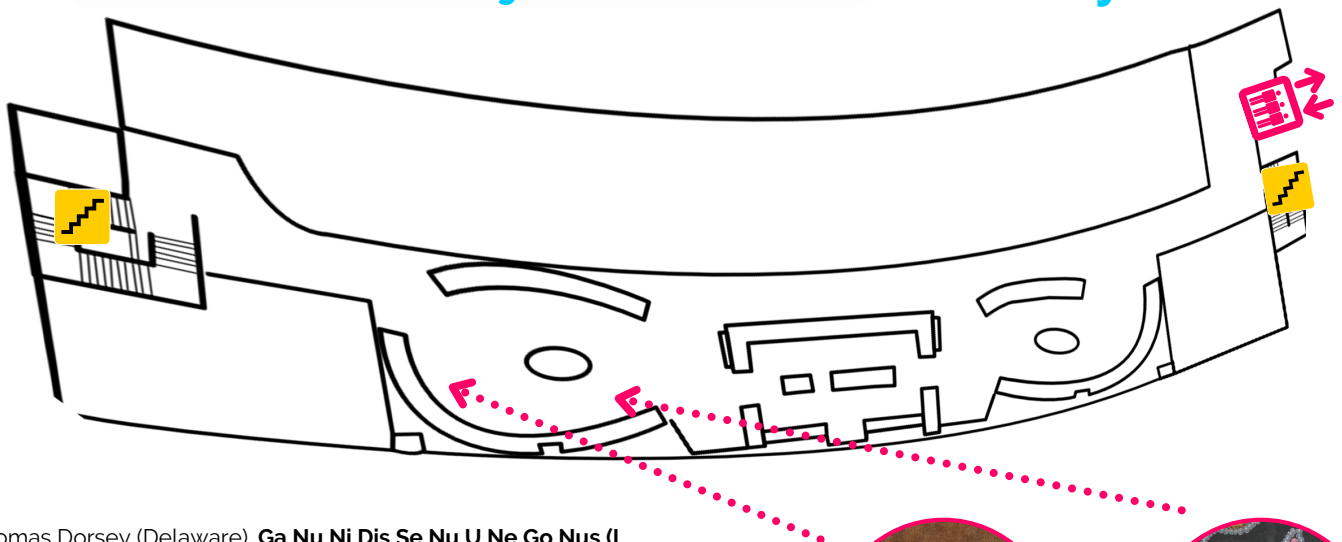


Panel: Treaty with the Delawares
