The images should accurately depict the whole object (all sides), include any additional images that provide details of any signatures or significant marks, including marks on the verso (back side of the work) or areas of damage. FAM also would like images of any related documents (identified below).

TERMS: This form does not create a contract for accepting the proposed gift. This form will be used to initiate the process of considering gifts. Once formally approved by all FAM administration, staff will notify the donors of the steps for accepting the objects into the museum's holdings. FAM accepts donations unconditionally. This means that the donated item(s) becomes the sole property of the Museum. Not all accepted items are placed on public exhibit, but all will be preserved for future generations and may be used for reasons other than exhibit purposes, including, but not limited to, research, educational programs, publications, and loans to other institutions.

FAM will not collect any of the following:

- FAM will not accept nor acquire human remains or funerary objects.
- FAM will not accept nor acquire items that are NAGPRA sensitive, including ceremonial items or otherwise items that are considered sacred or have cultural patrimony.
- FAM will not accept nor acquire precontact archaeological materials.
